Relocation and Support Program



Nunawading Community Hub, the new vibrant heart of Nunawading, is scheduled to open in Spring this year!

The hub will be a place where everyone will feel welcome and can come together to embrace new opportunities for learning, socialising and getting active.

The public opening will be on 5 September, subject to Victorian Government COVID-19 restrictions of the day.

Council looks forward to welcoming all Silver Grove community members to their new home and supporting you in the relocation and transition process.

Helping You Get Ready

With more than 20 diverse Silver Grove community groups with thousands of members and Council's Meals on

Wheels Service moving into the hub, Council has established a Relocation Support Team to help all of the groups prepare and learn about all the wonderful opportunities the hub has to offer.

Melinda Brown Coordinator Nunawading Community Centre is the Relocation Support Team Lead.

Melinda and her team will:

- work directly with all groups to plan and prepare for their relocation
- deliver a comprehensive program of regular communications so all community members know what's happening and what they need to do
- conduct orientation activities and provide resource materials so groups can learn about the spaces, facilities and operations of the hub.





Spaces and Operations at the Hub

The hub is a modern, fully accessible and flexible building purpose built for people of all ages and abilities.

Key features of the hub include:

- **Shared spaces** – a diverse range of multipurpose studios, meeting rooms and other shared spaces are available for groups to book and use, subject to availability. This includes nine studios, five meeting rooms of varying size and capacity, a large kitchen with indoor and outdoor dining, and a full-court stadium catering for basketball, badminton and other recreational activities.

Note: owing to particular service and OHS requirements, some groups will have dedicated areas within the hub.

- **Fully accessible** – featuring wide corridors, an internal lift and ramp, accessible car parking and parking for mobility scooters.
- **Prime location** – with Springvale Road frontage, the hub offers groups the opportunity to increase their visibility within, and connection with, the local community.
- **Modern technology** – all studios and meeting rooms have a large television screen, AV technology and Wifi (the Wifi is limited in content accessibility. User groups who want their own unlimited Wifi will need to provide separate plug-in Wifi devices). Training will be provided on the use of technology.
- **Comfortable environment** – furniture has been selected to ensure optimum comfort while also being practical and functional. There are lightweight and easy-to-stack chairs, comfortable occasional furniture in breakout spaces and climate-controlled heating/cooling in individual spaces.

Continued Planning for COVID-19

With the health and safety of all members of the Whitehorse community and Council staff the top priority, the Relocation Support Team will work closely with all groups to plan and implement procedures and policies in line with the latest Victorian Government's COVID-19 restrictions.

Additional hygiene standards and protocols will be in place once the facility is opened. You will be kept fully informed of these based on government directives at the time.
